 1. A Community Volunteer is essential for the sustained growth of the organization through public education and to encourage personal and community preparedness for pets and their owners at community events. Additional volunteer opportunities presented at the training.
 2. A Disaster Responder is offered basic and advanced training to help equip you to respond in a disaster situation involving companion animal (dogs, cats, other small animals). As a disaster responder in the field, you need to be comfortable with organized chaos, be in good physical health, and take the on-line Incident Command training (FEMA ICS-100 & NIMS-700).

Course Topics Include: Personal & Community Preparedness, Overview of the Incident Command System, Assisting in Shelter Set Up, Understanding Animal Behavior, Managing Stress, Personal Safety and more.
